- 6. Do you take into consideration Social Determinants of Health as part of your risk stratification model?
- 7. Do you set up a Shared Care Plan for those identified as high risk?
- 8. If you have a risk stratification tool, how often is it updated?
- 9. Do you use a registry to stratify the risk of your patients?
